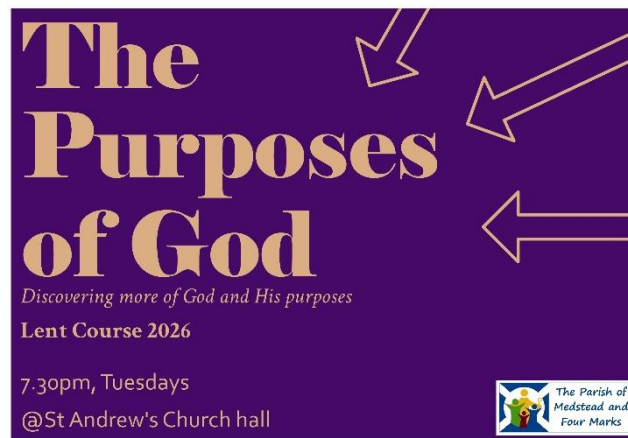
Tea & Chat and Tea & Bowls


